

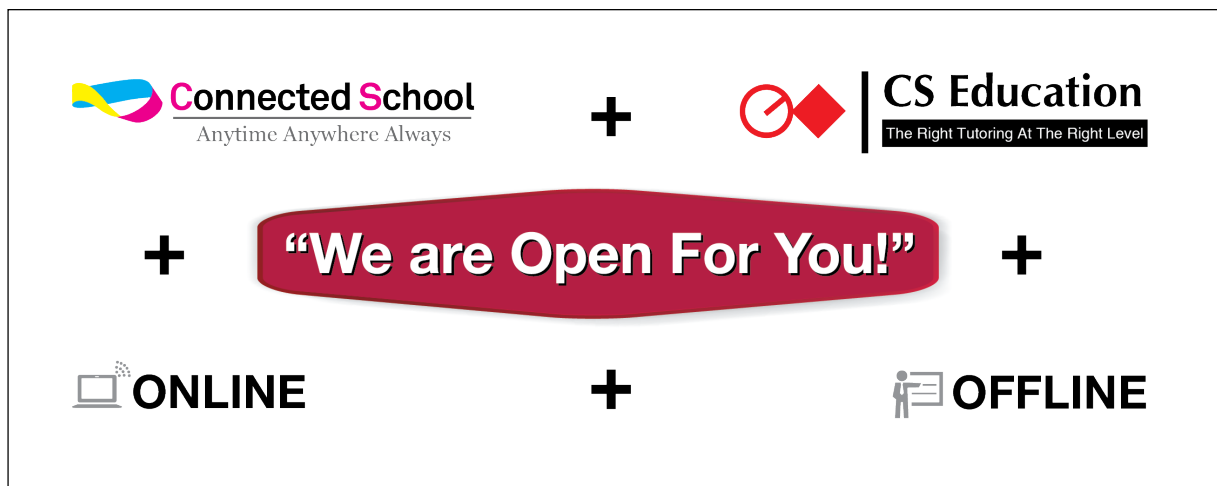

Available in Term 2

Offline and Online Learning Courses Available for Students in Term 2, 2020

As most of you are aware, CS Education has moved from off-line, face-to-face group lessons at our physical campuses to online lessons to be accessed from Monday 23 March 2020. Lessons will continue to be presented in this manner for the next 3 weeks of Term 1, and 2 weeks of holiday course.

In Term 2 (starting 27 April) we will open with our off-line courses on-campus as usual. In parallel, we will continue our online courses, to give parents and students the Online option. (This will only change, if prevailing circumstances demand it.) To keep up to date, please check the website, www.cseducation.com.au . All Term 2 Courses (Offline and Online) will commence from Monday 27 April 2020 at 4.30 pm.

Parents need to choose EITHER the Offline On-Campus option, OR the Online Computer-Based option! This is important to ensure that your children are catered for according to your needs.

Option 1 Offline On-Campus

- All courses will continue at the start of Term 2, 2020, but with enhanced support, which will provide an even better service. Details of this will follow.
- **Prices:** For prices of all courses refer to the existing brochures. The prices for 2020 have not changed.

Option 2 Online Study (Distance Learning)

- For students who have already registered with CS Education, they will be able to use their CS Education ID to access the Online Courses. For new students, they will have to begin the 7 Step Process from Step 1, i.e creating a CS Education ID and the initial diagnostic testing. (refer to the Distance Learning Handbook)
Books for the term need to be picked up from your campus. If this is not possible, contact the office to have them sent to you.
- **Prices:** For prices of all courses refer to the existing brochures. The prices for 2020 have not changed, but a 10% discount is available for all Comprehensive (WEMG) courses and a further 5% if paid by 17 April. For more details on pricing and procedures, consult the attachment at the end of this letter.

Pricing and Procedures for Term 2

A: For Offline On-Campus Courses

Prices

The prices for all Comprehensive Courses (WEMG) and all Trial Tests (OC, Selective) have not changed. Refer to the existing brochures.

Place

Off-line On-Campus Learners will continue scheduled lessons as usual at the normal venue, e.g. Norwest, Castle Hill.

Pick up of Books

Students will be provided with the necessary books during their first lesson as usual.

Payment Method

3. Internet banking

B: For Online Study (Distance Learning) Courses

Prices

For the Comprehensive (WEMG) Course, there is a 10% discount on the regular price for Term 2. There is also a further 5% promotion discount if you register and pay for the Term 2 WEMG course by the 17 April 2020.

The prices for the Trial Tests (OC, Selective) have not changed. Refer to the existing brochure.

Place

Online Learners will operate from home. For effective home learning they need the following:

1. Internet Access
2. A good computer
3. A sturdy desk
4. Their prescribed books
5. A quiet environment
6. Adherence to Instructions (Refer to the Distance Learning Handbook)

Pick up of Books

For online learners, there are 2 Options for this:

1. Pick up books from your CS Education campus. Do this by consultation (phone first to minimise queues at the centre).
2. Home delivery. There is a \$10 fee for this service. This is also done by consultation (phoning or website).
